Mr. Spangler asked Council to consider a January 4, 2016, Special meeting right after Commissioners meeting. An appropriation will need to be done so that the employee in the Surveyors office can be properly paid. The money was not laced into the fund for the employee to be paid.

Mr. Phil Taylor, Surveyor, said they want to take it out of perpetuation fund.

Ms. Donna Patterson, Settlement Clerk said it does not have to go to the State for approval.

#### Insurance-

Mr. Spangler said insurance and workers compensation looks good for 2015.

Apex (Primary Broker) is working with Delaware County to review claims through GPA (Third party administrator) and ELAP (review all claims over \$1000). There is no out of network in the plan. The rates will be published January 2016. Mr. Spangler reminded Council that there was not enough monies given toward 2016 insurance.

Quakenbush said 2016 budget does not have enough money to cover \$3.2 million in insurance.

Councilman Alexander said the anticipated rates was \$2.3 and new projection \$1.7. DLGF has not returned the call regarding this.

Special meeting will be immediately after the January 4, 2016 Commissioners meeting.

Mr. Ray Dudley, Sheriff, said he will provide a report at the beginning of 2016 showing stats of the arrests. Although it sounds bad, it is great that Delaware County is providing more arrests then other counties. The Task Force is very active in Delaware County.
