Ms. Ashley Soldaat, CASA Director, introduced herself to Council. She is the new CASA Director.

MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY, Councilwoman Lasater absent

MOTION: Councilman Nemyer motioned to approve for \$1,500,000 EDIT 1112.

SECOND: Councilman Jones

Ms. Pattie Lackey, Executive Assistant, said this request is for projects already approved.

Ms. Patterson, Settlement Clerk, said information had been sent to County Council with an explanation of projects.

Councilman Quakenbush said a realistic budget was not approved and that is why he did not vote for approval of the 2016 budget. Quakenbush is concerned about how health insurance, Ameresco and Sheriff Pension fund will be paid. There is no monies in EDIT to pay health insurance this year. The budget approved was \$5 million short.

Councilman Alexander shared the same concern as Councilman Quakenbush. If the Sheriffs Pension is not funded, the March 2016 payment cannot be made. Alexander asked if this will be on March 2016 agenda and asked Sheriff Ray Dudley if he is concerned.

President Matchett said it would be on the agenda.

Ms. Patterson checked and the payment is not due until April 1, 2016.

Mr. Dudley, Sheriff, said if the Pension is not paid, they will seek legal action. It is State law to fund the Sheriffs Pension.

Councilman Jones reminded everyone that "this" council is correcting the problem; however they did not create the problem.

Councilman Nemyer agreed that "this" Council is correcting the problem. Has this ever not been funded? Has a retiree ever not been paid...no, and that is how it is going to continue.

Councilman Jones said we can run around and try to intimidate the public or officers but we are not.

Mr. Dudley said they are not easily intimidated.

Councilman Quakenbush said there is not enough monies to pay bills for 2016, based on appropriations and amount approved by Department Local Government Finance (DLGF). Quakenbush does not agree with how the Pension Fund is managed.

Sheriff Dudley said Council spent a whole day during 2016 budget discussing the Pension Fund and Council decided to pay it out of public safety Local Option Income Tax (LOIT). LOIT is a supplement and is not a replacement. Council spent 10 minutes on PERF and decided to pay it.

Sheriff Dudley suggested Council to set a meeting for further discussion.

Councilwoman Chambers called for questions.

President Matchett said there has never been any intention not to fund the Sheriffs Pension. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY, Councilwoman Lasater absent

Before we go forward, Council should determine what they are going to do with Job Evaluation Committee. Two Council members should work with Mr. Rick Spangler, HR Director, and make proposed changes before Council to clarify who will do job descriptions and pay grades.

Councilman Quakenbush said two employees are hanging in limbo wondering what is happening in their position and pay. If the Chair would decide to accept motion than Council could do that.

Councilman Alexander said there is conflicting language in Job Evaluation Committee.

Councilman Quakenbush said consultants were hired to put information together; it was somewhat of different opinions with different HR Directors doing different procedures. This would take months to resolve and to determine who did what.

Mr. Don Dunnuck, Council Attorney, said it is up to Council to determine if Council or Human Resources is responsible regarding job descriptions and evaluations.

Further discussion took place regarding transfers of series, what goes to Personnel Committee and who is on the Personnel Committee and the same regarding Job Evaluation Committee.

A part-time employee was hired in the Commissioner's office and part-time monies was available for the hire. There was a lack of communication.

RESOLUTION 2009- 014

A RESOLUTION OF THE DELAWARE COUNTY COUNCIL TO JOIN THE CENTRAL INDIANA REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Central Indiana Regional Transportation Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") is a regional transportation authority duly established by ordinance of City-County of Indianapolis and Marion County, Indiana, pursuant to the provisions of Indiana Code Chapter 36-9-3, and consisting of the Consolidated City of Indianapolis and Marion County, Indiana, and such other counties or municipalities which the Authority may have been expanded to include; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-9-3-3 provides for the expansions of the Authority to include one (1) or more additional counties or municipalities within the same transportation planning district as designated by the Indiana Department of Transportation, if resolutions approving the expansion are adopted by the fiscal bodies of (a) the county or municipality to be added to the Authority, and (b) a majority of the counties and municipalities already in the Authority; and

WHEREAS, Delaware County, Indiana ("Delaware County") is located within the same transportation planning district as the Authority, and wishes to approve an expansion of the Authority to Include; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Council is the fiscal body of Delaware County;

IT IS THEREBY RESOLVED by the Delaware County Council as follows:

- The Delaware County Council hereby approves that the Central Indiana Regional Transportation Authority shall be expanded to include Delaware County, Indiana, subject to all of the rights, responsibilities and authority as established by Indiana Code Chapter 36-9-3 as limited by the ordinance of the City-Council of Indianapolis and Marion County, Indiana, creating the Authority.
- The expansion of the Authority to include Delaware County shall be
 effective upon the adoption of this Resolution, July _____, 2009, and the
 adoption of resolution approving the expansion by a majority of the
 countles and municipalities already in the Authority.
