AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE AN INVESTMENT POLICY AUTHORIZING THE INVESTMENT OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR MORE THAN TWO (2) YEARS BUT NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) YEARS ORDINANCE 2016-007

Mr. Gary Campbell, Delaware County Treasurer presented the ordinance and explained how it would help the County and what the law states. The Treasurer is responsible to invest funds.

Ms. Carrie Dye, Assistant Bookkeeper, said it is based on a percentage 25%. The Treasurer is limited to invest two years at the time, but if monies could be invested for 5 years, it could be at a higher interest rate. The ordinance has to be passed, per statute, by Council to invest for a longer time period. This is not monies that have been collected for taxes.

Quakenbush asked the status of the audit report currently taking place in the Treasurer's office.

Councilwoman Lasater said Mr. Bruce Hartman of Hartman and Associates is doing the Treasurers report and previously worked for State Board of Accounts. Councilwoman Lasater said "she" would trust the company.

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-007

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE AN INVESTMENT POLICY AUTHORIZING THE INVESTMENT OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR MORE THAN TWO (2) YEARS BUT NOT MORE THAN FIVE (5) YEARS

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Delaware County Treasurer to provide a high standard of safety, efficiency and profitability for the money that is receipted into Delaware County; and

WHEREAS, there exists investment opportunities that will increase the profit margin more than the ordinary savings account will allow; and

WHEREAS, current law establishes a maximum of two (2) years and the maximum amount that can be invested is twenty-five percent (25%) of total monies; and

WHEREAS, the investment officer believes that by establishing a policy pursuant to I.C. 5-13-9-5.7 that said fiscal officer (County Treasurer) by adopting an investment policy pursuant to said statute, said officer will have the opportunity to earn a higher percentage of interest; and

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to I.C. 5-13-9-5.7 the fiscal body hereby authorized the fiscal officer (County Treasurer) to invest public funds for more than two (2) years and not more than five (5) years.

FURTHER, that the investment of said funds must be made in accordance with I.C. 5-13-9-5.7.

That total investments under this policy shall be limited to not more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the total portfolio of public funds invested by the political subdivision, including balances in transaction accounts.

That this policy will be in effect on passage of this Ordinance and shall expire not more than four (4) years after date of passage.
