## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2017-005 AMENDMENT TO THE DELAWARE COUNTY SALARY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Council previously, on March 28, 2017, adopted Ordinance No. 2017-005, An Ordinance Defining Terms And Establishing Procedures For Hiring And Implementing Salaries For County Employees (Excluding Merit Officers); and

WHEREAS, the provisions of that Ordinance applicable to part-time Delaware County and employees in dispatch positions has not proven to be workable due to the training, testing, certification and stress associated with such positions; and

WHEREAS, any change in the Salary Ordinance will not require any additional appropriation beyond the approved 2018 budget for the 911 department;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Ordinance No. 2017-005 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Add a new Section 9.i. as follows:

\* Delaware County Communications

Part-Time 911 Employees:

- i. Starting in training: \$12.00 per hour for 28 hours per week;
- ii. Certified on one console (basic self-sufficient): \$14.00 per hour for 28 hours per week;
- iii. Certified to work all consoles (usually takes 9 months to one year): \$16.00 per hour for 28 hours per week.
- 2. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage by the County Council, in accordance with procedures as required by law.
