ORDINANCE FOR DELAWARE COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY GRANT
ACCEPTANCE AND FUND ESTABLISHMENT

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Emergency Management Agency has received a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant from FEMA is to have Delaware County Emergency Management Agency to update their hazard mitigation plan for Delaware County; and

WHEREAS, the uses of the funds are controlled by the grant agreement with FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners are supportive of the Delaware County Emergency Management Agency in receiving these funds and needs to set up a separate fund for the deposit and use of the funds by the Delaware County Emergency Management Agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DELAWARE COUNTY, INDIANA:


1. The grant provided to the Emergency Management Agency shall be accepted for the purpose of revising the hazard mitigation program of the County.
2. A separate fund shall be established by the Delaware County Auditor for the purpose of receiving any and all funds for the FEMA as awarded by for the Delaware County Emergency Management Agency to update the hazard mitigation program in the County.
3. The Delaware County Auditor shall issue a budget fund number of _____ with respect to the funds received by the Delaware County Emergency Management Agency and said funds shall be non-reverting.
4. Said funds shall reimburse expenses spent and shall be used by the Delaware County Emergency Management Agency, without appropriation, as per specified by the FEMA grant.
