RESOLUTION 25-50

WHEREAS, the Delaware-Muncie Metropolitan Plan Commission (DMMPC) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), as designated by the Governor of the State of Indiana, for the Muncie Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Policy Committee (TPC) is the policy committee of the Metropolitan Planning Organization involved in the transportation planning process for the Muncie Urbanized Area; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the FY 2026-2030 DMTIP to INDOT Project DES #2200995, District Wide Pedestrian Crossings, to add FY 2026 PE in the amounts of \$78,000 federal HSIP funds and PE \$8,000 State matching funds; and

WHEREAS, INDOT Project Des #2200995 was previously submitted to the Interagency Conformity Group (ICG) for confirmation of exempt status with and exempt status concurrence date of March 27, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment above was reviewed and approved by the Transportation Policy Committee at their meeting on October 15, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Transportation Policy Committee of the DMMPC as follows:

Section 1. That the FY 2026-2030 DMTIP be amended for INDOT Project Des#2200995, District Wide Pedestrian Crossings, FY 2026 in the amounts of \$78,000 federal HSIP funds and PE \$8,000 State funds as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

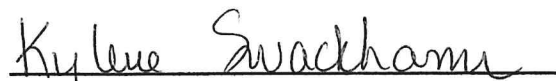
