**WHEREAS,** the proposed amendment to the FY 2026-2030 DMTIP to INDOT Project DES #2301081, SR 3 at CR 700 S 0.41mi, to add FY 2027 RW in the amounts of \$77,000 federal HSIP funds and RW \$8,000 State matching funds was requested by INDOT; and

**WHEREAS,** INDOT Project Des #2301081 was previously submitted to the Interagency Conformity Group (ICG) for confirmation of exempt status with and exempt status concurrence date of March 27, 2025; and

**WHEREAS,** the proposed amendment above was reviewed and approved by the Transportation Policy Committee at their meeting on October 15, 2025.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Transportation Policy Committee of the DMMPC as follows:

**Section 1.** That the FY 2026-2030 DMTIP be amended for INDOT Project Des#2301081, SR 3 at CR 700 S 0.41mi, to add FY 2027 RW in the amounts of \$77,000 federal HSIP funds and RW \$8,000 State funds as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

**Section 1.** That the FY 2026-2030 DMTIP be amended to add Delaware County project DES #2100088, Bridge #193, Memorial Drive over White River 920 feet west on Muncie Bypass, replace superstructure and deck, to add \$9,600 FY26 CN Federal STBG funds and \$2,400 FY26 CN local match funds, for a total of \$12,000 FY26 CN funds as shown on the attached Exhibit A.
