

ORDINANCE NO 2010-25

ORIGINAL

ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PAYMENT OF STIPENDS

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Council recognizes the opportunity for volunteers to assist Department Heads on projects throughout the year; and

WHEREAS, the County Council also recognizes the benefit that the volunteers could receive from the work experience and instruction they would receive; and

WHEREAS, the County could benefit from the use of said volunteer labor from time to time as the department head deems appropriate; and

WHEREAS, in order to encourage said volunteers to donate their time to the specific Department and in consideration for said volunteer work, the Council feels it would be appropriate to pay an individual stipend to said volunteers; and

WHEREAS, the payment of the stipend would be paid out of the budget for the Department benefiting from said volunteer; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance is not intended to interfere with, supersede, or obstruct the benefits and wages controlled by the Salary Ordinance or any collective bargaining agreements now in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, the payment of a stipend is not intended to change the nature and status of the person volunteering their time, said person shall be a volunteer and not an employee of Delaware County; and

WHEREAS, the payment of a stipend would be contingent upon Council's approval of the individual project, volunteer and amount proposed to be paid; and

WHEREAS, a volunteer may begin their volunteer work at the Department Head's discretion, and it is the responsibility of the Department Head to obtain Council's approval prior to payment of any stipend.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Delaware County Council, State of Indiana, that:


1. The Department Head can pay a volunteer a stipend upon Council approval; and
2. Said stipend shall come from the Department's budget that is benefiting from said volunteer; and
3. This ordinance shall not interfere with, supersede, or obstruct the benefits and wages controlled by the Salary Ordinance or any Collective Bargaining Agreements now in full force and effect.

4. This ordinance shall take effect upon the signing of the same.






