ORDINANCE NO 2011-011

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE AMOUNT OF THE  
ENHANCED EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM FEE

**WHEREAS**, Indiana Code § 36-8-16-5, the Delaware County Council as the fiscal body of Delaware County, Indiana, did heretofore establish an enhanced emergency telephone system fee (the "fee") for each exchange access facility used in the county; and


**WHEREAS**, Indiana Code § 36-8-16-7 permits the Delaware County Council to adopt an ordinance changing the amount of the fee subject to the limitations in the amount of any such fee that are set forth in IC §36-8-16-6; and

**WHEREAS**, based upon information provided by Delaware County by the service providers the County Council finds that the maximum fee would be permitted pursuant to the limitations set forth in IC § 36-8-16-6 would be the sum of \$0.98 per month; and


**WHEREAS**, the Delaware County Council finds that the reasonably anticipated capital expenditures, staff training, salary and other operations expenses to be incurred by the Delaware County Emergency Communications Department in the next year and beyond are such as to require additional levels of funding from that which results from the currently established fee;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the County Council of Delaware County, Indiana, that it does increase the amount of the enhanced emergency telephone system fee charged on exchange access facilities used or located within the county from the current monthly charge of \$0.57 to \$0.98 effective the 26<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2011.


