AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2013-003 ORDINANCE DEFINING INSURANCE FOR DELAWARE COUNTY RETIREES

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2013-003 "Ordinance Defining Insurance for Delaware County Retirees" was adopted on or about April 1, 2013.

WHEREAS, the Ordinance included, but was not limited to, eligibility requirements for retirement insurance coverage.

WHEREAS, for purposes of this amendment, the relevant portion of the Ordinance is as follows: "The Employee's age plus years of service shall equal at least seventy (70) years, with a minimum of ten (10) of those years being continuous years of service with Delaware County immediately preceding the date of retirement."

WHEREAS, as written the Ordinance precludes certain elected offices from eligibility for retirement insurance coverage, specifically those elected officials limited to consecutive terms that do not total ten (10) years cumulatively.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that in order to provide certain elected officials eligibility for retirement insurance coverage, the following language should be inserted immediately following the above cited portion of the Ordinance: "For elected officials serving in an office described in Article 6, Section 2, of the Indiana Constitution (clerk of the circuit court, auditor, recorder, treasurer, sheriff, coroner, or surveyor) who are prohibited from serving in that elected office for more than eight (8) years in any twelve (12) year period, the Employee's age plus years of service shall equal at least seventy (70) years, with a minimum of eight (8) of those years being continuous years of service with Delaware County immediately preceding the date of retirement."
