WHEREAS, the Indiana General Assembly passed Senate Bill 101-2015, (the "Religious Freedom and Restoration Act"), which was signed into law on March 26, 2015 (Senate Enrolled Act 101-2015) (Indiana Code section 34-13-9, et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Commissioners are opposed to the Indiana General Assembly's passage of the Religious Freedom and Restoration Act as Delaware County strives to create an inclusive and diverse environment where discrimination of any kind is not tolerated; and

WHEREAS, Delaware County believes that no individual should be discriminated against by another individual or body based upon that individual's sex, race, color, national origin, religion, disability, age, or sexual orientation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Delaware County Board of Commissioners, that:

- 1. Delaware County will continue its commitment to being a diverse, inclusive County and will remain opposed to discrimination of any kind.
- Delaware County urges the Indiana General Assembly to either repeal Senate Bill 101-2015, or to modify or clarify the law to include adequate protection against discrimination of our citizens and guests.
