RESOLUTION NO. 2016-______ RESOLUTION DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY DELAWARE COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Commissioners, have from time to time property which has been used by the various county departments and which is no longer needed a it has been replaced; and

WHEREAS, Delaware County EMS has determined that a certain vehicle a 2004-Ford-F350 (VIN# 1FTSX31L14EC57076) from its EMS fleet is no longer needed; and

WHEREAS, Monroe Township has determined that it has a need for the surplus vehicle to assist with Fire Fighting and Emergency Medical Services; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware County EMS currently provides Monroe Township with Comprehensive Emergency Medical Services in Monroe Township, located within the County of Delaware, and adjacent to the City of Muncie and,

WHEREAS, the provision of Comprehensive Emergency Medical Services in Monroe Township is advantageous for the public safety of both the Monroe Township, the City of Muncie, and Delaware County; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware County EMS is agreeable to provide the use of a vehicle for first responder activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DELAWARE COUNT, INDIANA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The vehicle, a certain 2004-Ford-F350 (VIN# 1FTSX31L14EC57076) presently in the EMS fleet and has been replaced and is now considered surplus and no longer of need or use by Delaware County.

SECTION 2. Monroe Township is a governmental entity located in Delaware County, Indiana and has expressed a need for the surplus vehicle to assist the Township and its fire department.

SECTION 3. Delaware County shall transfer to Monroe Township a certain vehicle, that being a 2004-Ford-F350 (VIN# 1FTSX31L14EC57076) for the purpose and use by the Monroe Township (Cowan) Volunteer Fire Department for use in providing fire service to the Township and surrounding area.

SECTION 4. The President of the Board of Commissioners shall be permitted to execute any and all documents and titles necessary to make the transfer of the surplus property.
