### COMMISSIONERS LIVE CERTIFICATE SALE SERVICES ADDENDUM TO THE SRI MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT

As part of, and in accordance with, the SRI Services Master Agreement (hereinafter "the agreement") between SRI, Incorporated (hereinafter "SRI"), 8082 Bash St., Indianapolis Indiana 46250, and Delaware County (hereinafter "the County"), by and through its Board of Commissioners, 100 West Main, Muncie, IN 47305. The County elects to obtain and upon acceptance hereof, SRI agrees to provide such services as herein defined in accordance with the terms of the agreement and this addendum.

#### 1. Description of SRI Services

The Commissioners Certificate Sale services to be performed by SRI, or as subcontracted by SRI, are more specifically described as follows:

- From various reports, data and information to be provided by the County Auditor, County Treasurer, and County Commissioners, SRI agrees to:
  - Prepare a list of properties eligible for sale at Commissioner's Sale (hereinafter the Certificate Sale List");
  - Prepare a plan of events and procedures required to carry out the sale pursuant to 6-1.1-24-6.1 et seq.;
  - Prepare all notices, publications, postings and other documents required to dispose of property pursuant to statute;
  - Prepare all applicable forms and records prescribed or approved by State Board of Accounts;
  - v. Conduct the sale or auction of properties; and
  - vi. Place a listing of pertinent sale information and properties on the SRI website.

4. Termination

This Addendum may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party at the addresses specified in the Agreement. In the event the Addendum is terminated by SRI, the County shall be entitled to all documents prepared by SRI and for which the County has paid the fees set forth in this Addendum.

#### 5. Ownership

2017.004 RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE INTENT TO CONDUCT A COMMISSIONERS' SALE TO SELL TAX SALE CERTIFICATES FOR PROPERTIES THAT ARE SEVERELY DELINQUENT IN PAYMENT OF PROPERTY TAXES.

WHEREAS, there are several properties in Delaware county that are severely delinquent in the payment of property taxes, having been offered for tax sales and which received no bids equal to or in excess of minimum sale price. The parcel numbers of those properties being attached to this as <u>"Exhibit</u> <u>A</u>", and

WHEREAS, there is an assessed value associated with these properties for taxation purposes, but no taxes are being collected, therefore causing a lower than expected tax distribution to those taxing units and taxing districts within which the properties are located, and

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Commissioners desire to have these properties back on the tax rolls with taxes being collected, and

WHEREAS, IC6-1.1-24-6, et seq. allows for the County Commissioners to acquire a lien on those delinquent properties and receive issuance of the tax sale certificates for those properties, without taking title to the properties, therefore limiting the liability and cost normally associated with taking title.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Delaware County Board of Commissioners that the County Executive shall acquire liens and receive tax sale certificates of the properties listed on <u>Exhibit A</u> that are severely delinquent and sell said certificates at a properly advertised Commissioner Tax Certificate sale.
