**RESOLUTION OF THE DELAWARE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
CONCERNING CUMULATIVE BRIDGE TAX LEVY**

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Board of Commissioners (hereinafter, the "Commissioners") adopted an ordinance to increase the possible tax levy for the Cumulative Bridge Fund pursuant to I. C. 8-16-3-1 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Council has gone through the budget process for the County and determined that the funds that would be gathered for the cumulative bridge fund, given the nature of the pandemic fiscal impact on local government, would be better served to reduce the cumulative bridge rate to the existing rate; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners also recognize that the demands for county services from the general fund have been exacerbated as a result of the pandemic and offer to the County Council to keep the existing rate for the cumulative bridge tax at \$.057 per one hundred dollars (\$100) of taxable real and personal property within the taxing unit for 2021.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DELAWARE COUNTY, INDIANA:


The Delaware County Board of Commissioners hereby concur that the cumulative bridge tax rate for the county should remain at \$.057 per one hundred dollars (\$100) of taxable real and personal property within the taxing unit for 2021.
