**RESOLUTION TO OPT BACK IN TO OPIOIDS SETTLEMENT
PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE 4-6-15-2**

WHEREAS, Delaware County, Indiana has been actively engaged in pursuing damages caused by the manufacture, sale, and distribution of opioids through outside counsel in multidistrict litigation; and


WHEREAS, recent legislation amending Indiana Code 4-6-15 has been adopted by the Indiana legislature and signed into law by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, Delaware County, Indiana, after due consideration of said legislation, has determined that it is in the best interest of its citizens to opt back into the opioids' settlements under Indiana Code 4-6-15-2.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Delaware County Board of Commissioners, that Delaware County, Indiana, having considered whether to elect to opt back in to the opioids settlements under Indiana Code 4-6-15-2, hereby resolves that Delaware County now exercises its election to opt back in to the opioid settlements, and orders its duly authorized agent to submit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Indiana Attorney General by July 15, 2022.

Duly adopted by the following vote of the members of said Board of Commissioners of Delaware County, Indiana this 21st day of March, 2022.




