RESOLUTION OF THE DELAWARE COUNTY, INDIANA BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO TRANSFER COUNTY-OWNED PROPERTY TO THE CARTHAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Board of Commissioners, as the legislative body and executive of Delaware County, Indiana (hereinafter, the "Commissioners"), owns certain personal property that is described as a 2010 Dodge Charger SUV with a total of 111,000 miles on it that was used by the Delaware County Sheriff for his Department's operations (hereinafter, the "County Property"); and

WHEREAS, the County Property is a surplus vehicle that the County Sheriff no longer requires to perform the Department's daily operations which should be donated; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Sheriff and the Commissioners desire to donate the County Property to the Carthage Police Department of Indiana at no charge; WHEREAS, the Carthage Police Department of Indiana desires to acquire the County Property from the Commissioners to be used in their daily operations; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DELAWARE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

- 1. The Delaware County Board of Commissioners shall transfer said County Property, as described above to Carthage Police Department, of Indiana upon acceptance of the Carthage Police Department.
- 2. The Carthage Police Department's acceptance of the County Property shall be demonstrated by transfer of the title from the County to the Carthage Police Department.
- 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
