**AN ORDINANCE FOR ELECTED DELAWARE COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS INELIGIBLE FOR
DELAWARE COUNTY HEALTH INSURANCE**

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Board of Commissioners are elected and serve for four (4) year terms.


WHEREAS, the Delaware County Board of Commissioners are the executive and legislative branch of local government, and

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Board of Commissioners set policies, pass ordinances, resolutions, and sign contracts, that govern all county employees. Those policies, ordinances, resolutions and contracts may set eligibility requirements for benefits such as health insurance.


WHEREAS, the Delaware County Board of Commissioners are elected to serve the best interest of the citizens of Delaware County.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that effective immediately upon the passage of this ordinance that no elected Delaware County Commissioner be entitled to health insurance benefits that are provided by this County. This ordinance would not prevent an employee that has retired and receiving insurance benefits prior to being elected County Commissioner.




