

ORDINANCE CONCERNING CODIFICATION

ORIGINAL

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ORDINANCE NO. 2013- 011

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Delaware County are obligated under State Law to codify ordinances, and,

WHEREAS, the proposed codification of ordinances has been presented to the Delaware County Commissioners, and,

WHEREAS, said codification shall be known as a Code of the County of Delaware, Indiana 2013; (*through April 2013*).

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Delaware County that the following titles and chapters be adopted as and for the codification of Delaware County:

Section 1. Purpose:

- A. A joint ordinance of the Board of Commissioners and the County Council of Delaware County adopting a County Code of Ordinances. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become "The Code of Delaware County, Indiana, through April 2013" (IC 36-1-3-6).

Passed and adopted by the Delaware County Commissioners on this 5 day of August, 2013.




