DISCUSSION REGARDING BUDGETS

President Nemyer had asked all Council to forward suggestions for cuts to line items within county general. Nemyer compiled the spreadsheet and provided it to all Council members. No public comments will be taken.

Councilman Alexander questioned the line item about Contractual Services on the spreadsheet.

Ms. Gale Bickell, Auditor Settlement Clerk, said she could not state exactly what those services include.

Councilman Matchett asked if they could be general IT services.

Ms. Judy Rust, Auditor, said Nikish tax system is over two departments in which IT pays from that account.

Councilman Jones said they would come down to the Auditor's Office to find out.

Councilman Alexander questioned equipment maintenance.

4:09 p.m.

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MOTION: Councilman Jones motioned to make reductions totaling \$340,000, as presented for county general.

SECOND: Councilwoman Chambers

Councilman Jones said Umbaugh suggested that Council make a similar reduction and this is close to what they had recommended.

Councilman Alexander said he noticed reductions in health insurance and asked where they are going to be.

Councilman Jones said this is not "all inclusive" and was submitted to "him."

Councilman Spangler asked that they go through the spreadsheets.

Councilman Jones read aloud departments.

Councilman Matchett said Umbaugh suggested \$352,000.

Councilman Spangler asked if money is needed for November 2013 referendum.

President Nemyer said he does not think so.

Ms. Bicknell asked if Council had checked with insurance to see if the county could make it on what is left; this line item is reimbursed from City of Muncie.

Councilman Alexander said the projections are showing that the county would be out of money in October, 2013, does this affect that?

Ms. Bicknell said \$144,000 remains in the line item.

Ms. Dunnuck said the expense report given by Ms. Donna Patterson to Council at the last meeting said the budget amount was \$293.000.

Ms. Bicknell said her budget amount started at \$273,000 and ending balance is \$144,000.

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President Nemyer said when the suggestion was made as of July 1, 2013 there was \$293,000 budgeted, \$110,000 spent, leaving a balance of \$182,000.

Councilman Matchett stated as of July 22, 2013 it was \$110,746 spent, leaving a balance of \$182,253.

Ms. Bicknell said her report is as of August 9, 2013, \$273,000 in budget and a transfer of \$20,000 out of it at the beginning. Year to date expense is \$128,254.23.

Councilman Jones said that is going to need to be resolved in the Auditor's Office.

Councilman Alexander said the year to date expense should be the same even if as of July 22, 2013 the budgeted amount was \$293,000.

Ms. Bicknell said her expense is \$128,254.43.

Council's is \$110,746.

Councilman Alexander said if this is voted on (today, August 9, 2013), will these need to be in transfers.

Ms. Dunnuck said they are not transfers, if this is voted on then an ordinance will be introduced at Council meeting (August 27, 2013).

Councilman Spangler asked for a balance on overtime.

Ms. Bicknell said balance for overtime is \$28,070.89. Bicknell said the balance line by line should be checked to make sure the money is there.

Councilman Jones said if it is going to be reduced more than what is left, that is a problem.

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Ms. Rust said Auditor's Office did not see the spreadsheet until it was presented at the meeting.

Councilman Jones wanted it stated "for the record" that Ms. Rust and Ms. Bicknell wrote current balance for each account as of date on spreadsheet.

MOTION: Councilman Jones motioned to amend the original motion to reduce page 8, line item 312 to \$5,000, delete page 14, line item 441 and page 34, line item 173 change amount to \$105,500. This will place the end number at \$340,000.
