DELAWARE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ORDINANCE FOR JUVENILE COURT FAMILY RECOVERY COURT

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Juvenile Court has been awarded a Court Improvement Program Grant by the Indiana Supreme Court Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Juvenile Court/Circuit Court 2 is being awarded this grant to implement a Family Recovery Court; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is supportive of the Delaware County Juvenile Court/Circuit Court 2 receiving these funds and needs to set up a separate non-reverting fund for the deposit and use of the grant funds by the Delaware County Juvenile Court/Circuit Court 2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DELAWARE COUNTY, INDIANA:

- A Separate non-reverting fund shall be established by the Delaware County Auditor
 for the purpose of receiving any and all funds for the Delaware County Juvenile
 Court/Circuit Court 2 as awarded by the State of Indiana Court Improvement
 Program Grant for the Juvenile Court Family Recovery Court.
- 2. Said grant funds shall be deposited into this non-reverting fund and shall be used by the Delaware County Juvenile Court/Circuit Court 2, without appropriation, as per specified by the Delaware County Circuit Court 2 Judge.

I am pleased to inform you that your grant application has been approved as follows: 1) \$8,350 in basic grant funds (\$3,000-program evaluation, \$1500-incetives, \$500-supplies, \$500-copying/printing/postage, \$2850-one computer/tablet/laptop, software, storage device); and 2) \$4767 in training grant funds (\$500 to host two local training events, \$200- travel costs for site visits to Grant and Marion Counties, \$65-travel costs for Problem Solving Court Coordinator Orientation, \$4002-National Association of Drug Court Professionals membership fees, registration fees and travel expenses for two drug court team members).
