RESOLUTION 2020—014

AN AMENDMENT TO A RESOLUTION CREATING A VOLUNTARY COUNTY FURLOUGH PROGRAM

WHEREAS,	the President of the United States has declared a national emergency for the Covid-19 novel virus; and
WHEREAS,	the Governor of Indiana has declared a public health emergency for Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak ("COVID-19") pursuant to I.C. 10-14-3-12; and
WHEREAS,	during this national emergency the local economy has stopped and the State has extended deadlines on the payment of real and personal property taxes to the County; and
WHEREAS,	allowances need to be made for the benefit of the County and the costs of services; and
WHEREAS,	the Governor of the State of Indiana has implemented a process for getting Indiana back to work and government operating to serve the citizens; and
WHEREAS	the Commissioners created a furlough program for employees that volunteer to be furloughed for 12 weeks as a start to conserve the financial resources of the County.
WHEREAS	the Commissioners desire to extend the furlough program for an additional 2 weeks to start on May 28, 2020 under same terms conditions as the original resolution and terminating on August 5, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DELAWARE COUNTY that:

- 1. The Board of Commissioners desires to extend the signup period for the furlough program for an additional 2 weeks to allow the Elected Officials and Department heads to seek volunteers to participate in the furlough program.
- County employees (volunteers) will be furloughed for a period of 10 weeks starting May 28, 2020 until August 5, 2020.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the furlough program as set forth in Resolution 2020-010 shall remain in place.

4. This Resolution shall expire on August 6, 2020.
