





A RESOLUTION OF THE DELAWARE COUNTY COUNCIL
AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE ENTRY INTO AN
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR A JOINT COMMUNICATIONS CENTER

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-1-7-1, et seq. (the "Interlocal Law") authorizes political subdivisions to enter into interlocal cooperation agreements for the joint exercise of powers; and

WHEREAS, Delaware County (the "Government Entity") operates an emergency dispatch and communications center serving the City of Muncie and Delaware County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Government Entity has determined that the joint exercise of the power to operate and fund such a center with the City of Muncie is desirable and best serves the interests of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Law requires that any interlocal cooperation agreement be approved and authorized by resolution or ordinance of a participating Government Entity; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Council (the "Fiscal Body"), desires to authorize the entry into an interlocal agreement for the joint exercise of the power to operate and fund an emergency dispatch and communications center;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DELAWARE COUNTY COUNCIL
AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Fiscal Body does hereby authorize and approve the entry by the Government Entity into the Interlocal Agreement a copy of which is attached hereto (the "Agreement").
2. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage, execution of the Agreement by all parties thereto and upon compliance with the procedures required by law.
