

# **TECHNIAL SUPPORT UNIT 18 (TSU-18)**

Technical Support 18 or (TSU18) is an apparatus that is operated and maintained by the Delaware County Homeland Security / Emergency Management Agency. TSU18 is specially equipped with resources to assist in technical support for emergency response agencies, their personnel and incident command.



## TSU18 can be used by police fire and EMS for Many different incidents including:

- Emergency Service personal rehabilitation for large or long scale incidents or emergencies.
- Sheltered Incident Command Post
- Field Interview shelter for law enforcement
- Shelter Post for Disasters

## TSU18 Also Provides the Following Resources:

- Zumro and EZ Up tents (multiple sizes)
- Ø Folding Cots
- 3 portable generators with scene lighting
- ☑ Tables
- Portable Oxygen
- Traffic control supplies including cones, flares, and signs
- Radio base station with 800 and VHF radios
- ☑ Internet Hot Spot

## **Rehab for Emergency Responders Include:**

- Cold and Hot drinks such as Gatorade, water and coffee
- ☑ Ice Towels
- ☑ Misting fans
- ☑ Heaters
- $\boxtimes$  Cooling Station
- ☑ Blankets
- Protein bars
- MRE (Meals Ready to Eat)



First Responder Agencies in Delaware County can request the TSU-18 to be deployed for field operations by requesting 911-dispatch to notify EMA during an incident.
