

TECHNIAL SUPPORT UNIT 18 (TSU-18)

Technical Support 18 or (TSU18) is an apparatus that is operated and maintained by the Delaware County Homeland Security / Emergency Management Agency. TSU18 is specially equipped with resources to assist in technical support for emergency response agencies, their personnel and incident command.



TSU18 can be used by police fire and EMS for Many different incidents including:

- Emergency Service personal rehabilitation for large or long scale incidents or emergencies.
- Sheltered Incident Command Post
- Field Interview shelter for law enforcement
- Shelter Post for Disasters

TSU18 Also Provides the Following Resources:

- Zumro and EZ Up tents (multiple sizes)
- Ø Folding Cots
- 3 portable generators with scene lighting
- ☑ Tables
- Portable Oxygen
- Traffic control supplies including cones, flares, and signs
- Radio base station with 800 and VHF radios
- ☑ Internet Hot Spot

Rehab for Emergency Responders Include:

- Cold and Hot drinks such as Gatorade, water and coffee
- ☑ Ice Towels
- ☑ Misting fans
- ☑ Heaters
- \boxtimes Cooling Station
- ☑ Blankets
- Protein bars
- MRE (Meals Ready to Eat)



First Responder Agencies in Delaware County can request the TSU-18 to be deployed for field operations by requesting 911-dispatch to notify EMA during an incident.
