We have reviewed your application for CAPTA grant funds and are pleased to inform you that we are awarding you \$15,000 in CAPTA grant funds under the category of counties with high, unmet need. The funds must be used consistently with your grant application and must be for the purpose of expanding GAL/CASA services.

Courts receiving CAPTA grants must submit a semi-annual report to the Indiana Supreme Court, Division of State Court Administration, State Office of GAL/CASA. As the CAPTA grant terms and conditions state, you are required to track how the CAPTA funds are spent to increase your volunteer base and/or the number of children who are appointed a GAL/CASA volunteer. If you are starting a specific recruitment campaign or diversity initiative with CAPTA funds, please monitor the success you have from the campaign and/or initiative so we can report this information.

Thank you for your hard work in striving to provide GAL/CASA services to all the children in your community. We hope these grant funds will assist you greatly in your efforts.
