ORDINANCE NO. 2009- 085

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A ONE TIME TRANSFER OF SURPLUS FUNDS FROM DELAWARE COUNTY EMS 457 PENSION FUND TO DELAWARE COUNTY CUMULATIVE BUILDING FUND 405

WHEREAS, Delaware County Emergency Medical Service has a surplus of \$500,000.00 in its 258 2585 00000 390 account.

WHEREAS, this account was established to hold funds received for Delaware County EMS 457 pension fund through user fees.

WHEREAS, that due to an increase in call volume, this excess has occurred. And the fee per call has been reduced from \$39.00 to \$25.00 to reduce the surplus growth.

WHEREAS, the Delaware County EMS 457 plan is fully funded and removal of the \$500,000.00 will have no effect on the plan now or in the future.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Council of Delaware County, State of Indiana, that:

1. The surplus amount of \$500,000.00 shall be transferred from the Delaware County Emergency Medical Service 258 2585 00000 390 account to the Delaware County Cumulative Building Fund 405.
2. That this shall be a one time only transfer to be used by the Delaware County Commissioners for updating and maintaining Delaware County Properties.
3. This Ordinance shall be effective when adopted.






