## A RESOLUTION OF DELAWARE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ENCOURAGING THE PRESERVATION OF DELAWARE COUNTY, AND OTHER INDIANA JOBS

WHEREAS, the United States Congress is debating the President's plan to make college more affordable; and,

WHEREAS, among many issues involved in said debate is the issue of potentially eliminating private student lenders; and,

WHEREAS, Sallie Mae and its 8,500 employees across the country, including 2,300 in Indiana, are "at risk" in said debate; and,

WHEREAS, Sallie Mae is a major employer in Delaware County and East Central Indiana; and,

WHEREAS, Sallie Mae, its employees and leadership have been significant supporters of the community in many ways; and,

WHEREAS, the Delaware County Commissioners, on behalf of all residents of Delaware County is supportive of responsible actions by Congress which will recognize appropriate cost saving measures while protecting valuable jobs for Indiana families; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Delaware County Commissioners, meeting in regular session, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That the United States Congress is hereby encouraged to adopt a student loan reform proposal that makes college more affordable and achieves significant taxpayer savings while also protecting Delaware County, Indiana jobs, other Indiana jobs, our families and communities.

SECTION 2. That a copy of this Resolution shall be provided to all members of the Indiana Congressional delegation forthwith as an expression of the concern and desire of the County of Delaware, Muncie, Indiana.

SECTON 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and upon its adoption.
