## ORDINANCE NO. 2011 – 026A EMS FUNDS INTO COUNTY GENERAL FUNDS AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 2006-001

WHEREAS, Delaware County has established certain fees associated with emergency response of the EMS Dept. for a charged and collected run.

WHEREAS, Delaware County places these fees in established accounts based on the amount stipulated at the times these fees are collected.

WHEREAS, To better clarify the process and to allow for more money to be deposited into the General Fund account throughout the year, the County Commissioners wish to establish a flat amount for each fund

WHEREAS, These Funds consist of the following four (4) fund accounts being; Capital Improvements Fund, Ambulance Replacement Fund, 457 Fund, and Medical Supplies Fund

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF DELAWARE COUNTY that: Beginning August 1, 2011 that the only amount of money to be deposited into the four accounts each month will be as follows:

Capital Improvements: \$16,000.00
Ambulance Replacement: \$4,500.00

457 Fund: \$9,200.00

Medical Supplies: \$12,500.00

The benefit is to place additional money into the general fund account to assist in the cost cutting expectations established due to less revenue generated by property taxes

That should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid the remainder of said ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.
