Mr. Mike King, Clerk of Delaware County, said he worked with the consultant regarding the 4-D program. The 4-D program is when federal government gives back funds as incentives payments for performance based on child support collections and administrative costs. The Clerk's office did back billing on claims for part of 2014 and 2015. The State accepted the back billing. The Clerk's office will receive \$64,324 to be placed back to the general fund.

Board of Judges, Court administrative and the Clerks staff, have worked and implemented e-filing for the court systems. State of Indiana trained the Clerk's office. The first date for implementing e-filing was July 7, 2017. The goal is to be paperless and not to pay rent on a storage space.
