- The Delaware County Board of Commissioners is the purchasing agent specified in I. C. 36-1-10.5-3 for the purpose of purchasing real estate and improvements with a common address of 3100 S. Tillotson Ave., Muncie, IN, identified as Parcel No. 18-11-20-351-006.000-003.
- The Board of Commissioners shall appoint two (2) appraisers to appraise the fair market value of the land and structures located at 3100 S. Tillotson Ave., Muncie, IN.
- The Board of Commissioners shall be permitted to purchase the real estate and improvements for not more than the average of the two (2) appraisals or \$2,850,000 whichever is less.
- The appraisers appointed by the Board of Commissioners shall return their separate appraisals to the Board of Commissioners no later than thirty (30) days after their appointment.
- The Board of Commissioners shall keep copies of the two (2) appraisals for a period
 of five (5) years from the date that the appraisals are returned to the Board of
 Commissioners.
- The Board of Commissioners shall also provide a copy of the appraisals to the County Council upon receipt from the appraisers.
