CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this 19 day of March 2019 and between Eric M. Hoffman, Prosecuting Attorney of Delaware County hereinafter called "Prosecutor's Office" and Lorie Craycraft, Administrator of Delaware County Prosecutor's Office Family Support Division hereinafter called "Family Support" and Jayne Meranda, Director of Delaware County Community Corrections hereinafter called "Delaware County Community Corrections" and court ordered child support clients hereinafter called "Participants."

WHEREAS, Family Support has proposed to pay towards the salary of staff persons for Adult Community Service at Delaware County Community Corrections with Title IV-D Incentive funds, and

WHEREAS, the parties have reached an agreement concerning the arrangement for such payment to Delaware County Community Corrections for providing supervision of court ordered participants from Family Support through Title IV-D Court who will be entered into a sanction program designed to encourage the participant to be in compliance with Title IV-D Court orders by the following program:

- 1) Non-custodial parents who are not in compliance with Title IV-D Court Orders shall be order to make a sum certain payment every week OR shall perform sixteen (16) hours of community service through Delaware County Community Corrections.
- 2) Should the non-custodial parent not make said weekly sum certain payment as ordered and fail to perform sixteen (16) hours of community service per week as ordered, the person may be found in contempt of court and imprisoned.
- 3) The Delaware County Prosecutor Family Support Division will be responsible for informing Delaware County Community Corrections through electronic messaging if a court ordered person makes a payment on the support order.
- 4) Delaware County Community Corrections will be responsible for monitoring attendance for the participant in the community service program and report compliance to the Family Support Office through electronic messaging.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the parties hereto agree as follows:

Delaware County Prosecutor's Office Family Support Division will be responsible for payment of \$15,000.00 towards the salary of staff persons from the Adult Community Service component of Delaware County Community Corrections at commencement of



referral program from Family Support to be paid from the County General Incentive Funds.


This Contract will be effective one year from the date of commencement and renewable/changeable with agreement between both parties.
