

There has been some confusion about the services offered at our Self Help Legal Center. We have attorneys available on various afternoons, 1:30 – 4:00 pm, (check posted calendars) to help with filling out paperwork offered in the center. They are NOT here to offer legal advice. The attorneys may give some advice that applies to the paperwork they are assisting a person with but are not here just for legal advice. There are a couple reasons for this. First, the attorneys may not have knowledge of all areas of law so the attorney may not know how to advise on certain situations. Second, there are services already in place for this.
