# **Muncie Community Schools**

Will there be meal assistance for students while schools are closed? MCS will offer breakfast and lunch meals for students in a variety of ways.

We will continue offering breakfast and lunch meals at four sites on a daily basis, including the week of spring break. Breakfast will be distributed between 7:30-8:30 a.m. Lunch will be distributed between 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

Beginning Monday, families may choose to pick-up a 10 meal packet (5 breakfast & 5 lunches). Families will not need to get out of the car. A drive-thru will be set up for easy access at the following locations:

DelCom Schools will begin serving lunches from 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, beginning Monday, March 30th, at Albany Elementary, Eaton Elementary and DeSoto United Methodist Church.

For the Albany area, but open to anyone, Integris Community Church (356 West State Street in Albany), will continue providing lunches from 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. through this Friday, March 20th.

The Albany Lions Club (215 S. Walnut Street in Albany), will be serving lunches from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. beginning Monday, March 23 through Friday, March 27.

All of the above are drive up/pick up and are open to any children, even preschool aged children.

### **Daleville Community Schools**

Daleville Community Schools is providing weekly packets of meals (5 breakfasts & 5 lunches) until further notice. Online order forms are sent out to parents weekly through our school messaging system and are due on Thursdays at 3:00pm. Meals are picked up on Mondays at the elementary school between 10-2pm using the student drop-off lane. Over 500 students were fed this week.

### Wes-Del Community Schools

Wes-Del Community Schools has been providing lunches to all students between 12PM and 1PM each day. Pickup is available at the Wes-Del Elementary in Gaston. We instructed the parents to pull up or walk up to the sidewalk and we will take the lunch out to them. We are not letting parents or students inside the building.

Wes-Del Community Schools have fed nearly 50 students daily this week. We begin spring break on Friday, March 20th through Monday, March 30th. During that time the Gaston Church will be providing lunches for our students. The extra food that was going to expire over spring break has been given to churches in the Town of Gaston. The churches have food banks and their staff was going to give the food out to the Gaston Community.

# Liberty Perry Schools

Liberty Perry Schools in Selma will have curb side grab and go sack meals for students 18 and younger starting Tuesday, March 17, 2020. Drive up to the office doors at Selma Elementary and someone will bring food to you. Please stay in your car. This service is available from 11:00-12:30 M-F.
