**EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY** 

RE: Nursing Home Codes/Cardiopulmonary Arrests

All Nursing Home Codes/Cardiopulmonary Arrests shall be worked on scene at the nursing home.

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic Full PPE must be donned prior to entering and starting any resuscitation.

Verify code status.

- If full code, resuscitate per protocol on scene.
- 2. If full code, and in the paramedic's discretion, resuscitation would appear to be futile, the medic will call online medical control and speak with the physician on duty asking for DNR/DNI order and termination of resuscitation efforts.
  - a. If DNR/DNI given, contact coroner on duty.
    - i. If decedent has funeral home arrangements leave at scene and funeral home to get decedent.
    - ii. If decedent has no funeral home arrangement transport directly to the morgue after a barrier has been placed over the decedent's face.
  - b. If ordered to work the code/cardiac arrest, continue resuscitation per protocol
    - i. Recommend 20 minutes and/or 3 rounds of drugs
      - 1. No ROSC pronounce dead.
    - ii. Consider early termination
- 3. If return of spontaneous circulation (ROSC) occurs transport to the emergency department.
  - a. Follow post resuscitation protocols
