

**An Ordinance of Delaware County, Indiana, creating a Fund for the Deposit of Funds Received by the Delaware County Emergency Management Agency from the Ball Brothers Foundation to provide funding for the purchase of equipment**

**WHEREAS**, the Delaware Emergency Management Agency (DCEMA) has received grant funds from the Ball Brothers Foundation to provide funding for purchase of equipment, namely a small unmanned aircraft system to assist DCEMA in its duties and functions; and


**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to establish a fund in the Auditor's Office into which the proceeds will be deposited and from which expenditures will be disbursed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** that the Auditor shall establish a fund entitled Delaware County Emergency Management Agency Grant fund for Equipment and said Auditor has issued a budget fund number of \_\_\_\_\_ with respect to these funds and such funds are non-reverting. Further, since the grant budget is approved and non-reverting, the expenditure of said funds shall not require appropriation by Delaware County Council.
