A drone will cut the job in half by locating someone that is hurt, stuck inside a burning building, etc. The drone will assist the Sheriff's office on crash sites. The plan is to have the drone available within 15 minutes. A kit, drone, battery, microphone, speaker, night vision, spot light is included on drone. Pilots will be trained. The drone is insured.

Mr. Kelly Bryant, said it is needed during Court. This is a directive from the Board to change this so that laptops are available during court to be used by the Public Defenders. Trouble shooting will be nice because all departments will use the same system. This would be property of Delaware County. Staff members will have a laptop and desktop. Attorneys have never been provided any equipment from Delaware County. This system will be used in the Court room and will allow to be paperless, not carrying in files of papers into the courtrooms. Public Defenders do not have office space; however, Public Defenders will have a landing spot in the new facility.
